Ensuring environmental sustainability, ecological balance, protection of flora and fauna, animal welfare, agro forestry, conservation of natural resources and maintaining quality of soil, air and water [including contribution to the Clean Ganga Fund set-up by the Central Government for rejuvenation of river Ganga].
- 5. Protection of national heritage, art and culture including restoration of buildings and sites of historical importance and works of art; setting up public libraries; promotion and development of traditional art and handicrafts;
- 6. Measures for the benefit of armed forces veterans, war widows and their dependents;
- 7. Training to promote rural sports, nationally recognised sports, Paralympics sports and Olympic sports
- 8. Contribution to the prime minister's national relief fund or any other fund set up by the central govt. for socio economic development and relief and welfare of the schedule caste, tribes, other backward classes, minorities and women;
- 9. Contribution to incubators funded by Central Government or State Government or any agency or Public Sector Undertaking of Central Government or State Government, and contributions to public funded Universities, Indian Institute of Technology (IITs), National Laboratories and Autonomous Bodies (established under the auspices of Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR), Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR), Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR), Department of Atomic

Energy (DAE), Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO), Department of Science and Technology (DST), Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology) engaged in conducting research in science, technology, engineering and medicine aimed at promoting Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).]

- 10. Rural development projects
- 11. Slum area development
- 12. Disaster management, including relief, rehabilitation and reconstruction activities.

The Board is requested to approve payment of Rs. 25,27,667/- for spending on any of the activities specified above.

REGARDING INCREASE IN MONTHLY REMUNERATION OF COMPANY SECRETARY, HSRDC

It is submitted that vide request letter dated 07.12.2022 (Annexure-E), Mrs. Dolly Gaur, Company Secretary, HSRDC has submitted the following:

- 1. That she was appointed as a full-time Company Secretary of HSRDC at a monthly remuneration of Rs. 40,000 w.e.f. 01.04.2019 on the basis of walk-in interview conducted by HSRDC on 21.02.2019.
- 2. That she was enrolled as a certified member of The Institute of Company Secretaries of India (ICSI) in the month of Sept. 2013 and hence, she possesses 9+ years of post-qualification work experience as Company Secretary.
- 3. HSRDC was incorporated in the year 1999 and has a paid—up capital of Rs. 122.04 crores and hence, there are numerous legal and secretarial compliances applicable on the Corporation. Since no full-time Company Secretary had been appointed in HSRDC till April 2019, the Corporation lacked several compliances as specified by Companies Act. With support of management and utmost dedication and hard work, she streamlined all legal and secretarial compliances within a short span of merely 2 months from her joining date, failing which the Company could also get INACTIVE status as per directions of Ministry of Corporate Affairs of India. Consequently, various Audit Paras pending with Committee on Public Undertakings (COPU) owing to several pendencies of Secretarial work over the past few years have also been dropped out by COPU at meeting dated 04.01.2022.
- 4. It is further intimated to the Board that as per approval accorded by the Board of Directors, HSRDC in its 81st meeting dated 20.05.2020; her monthly remuneration was enhanced to Rs. 42,000 which was further enhanced by the Board at its 83rd meeting held on 11.11.2020. She is presently being paid Rs. 55,000 per month as fixed remuneration but since then, there has been no increase in her salary.
- 5. She further states that the scope of work of a Company Secretary depends upon the paid-up capital of a Company and the salary being paid to other Haryana Govt. Corporations with less paid-up capital and requiring less secretarial compliances is comparatively quite high.

A table showing comparison of paid-up capital and salary being paid to Company Secretary in Haryana Corporations is given below:
