The Financial Commissioner & Principal Secretary to Govt. Haryana Health and Medical Education Department vide letter no. 20/59/2011-5HB III dated 27.06.2011 accorded administrative approval amounting to Rs. 20.00 Cr. for construction of additional block at District Hospital Rewari. Accordingly, the detailed estimate was got technically sanctioned for Rs. 539.66 Lacs and the work was allotted to the contractual agency for an agreement amount of Rs. 549.42 Lacs with a time limit of 15 months. The date of start of this work was 27.12.2012 and the date of completion was 26.03.2014. The specifications were revised by the committee constituted at the level of Govt, and the cost of Civil and other Misc, works were increased. In the mean while the Govt, accorded revised administrative approval of this work for an amount of Rs. 5.00 Cr. vide Additional Chief Secretary to Govt. Haryana Health Department letter no. 20/59/2011-5HB III dated 24.12.2014. The work could not be completed within the revised administrative approval of Rs. 5.00 Cr. and as such revised rough cost estimate for an amount Rs. 1138.23 Lacs has been sent to Director General Health services Haryana vide this office letter no. 5259/HSRDC dated 14.09,2015 for arranging the revised administrative approval. In the revised rough cost estimate provision for E.I. Internal, estate services, CCTV camera system, street light, DG set, LAN system, 2 nos. bed elevator & Air Conditioner, Substation etc., for an amount of Rs. 430.58 Lacs has been made.

The total expenditure for an amount Rs. 499.49 Lacs has been incurred on this work and a bill for Rs. 56,28,259/- is pending and balance work approximate Rs. 150.00 Lacs to be carried out for completion of Civil work including PH work and Electrical work.

I would request you to look into the matter at personal level and revised administrative approval for an amount Rs. 1138.23 Lacs as already requested vide this office letter no. 5259/HSRDC dated 14.09.2015, may kindly be got issued at the earliest, so that the work could be got completed.

CONSTRUCTION OF H.L. BRIDGE ON YAMUNA RIVER CONNECTING BILASPUR TO KHOJKIPUR ROAD OF DISTRICT PANIPAT AND TANDA KURDI-NANGAL SAI MANDIR, CHAPROLI BAROT ROAD, IN UTTAR PRADESH STATE.

- There is a proposal to construct a High Level Bridge on Yamuna River connecting Baghpat
 District in Uttar Pradesh and District Panipat in Haryana State alongwith its approaches and
 protection work on 50:50 cost share basis.
- The site of proposed bridge was located near village Hathwala in Panipat district of Haryana State and in village Chaproli on the other side in UP State. The length of the proposed bridge was about 668 Mtrs. The bridge will provide a direct connectivity to the villages of District Bhagpat (UP) with the villages of District Panipat (Haryana). The farmers of both the states will be benefited from this Bridge in many ways.
- As per estimate, the project cost of the bridge was Rs. 10868.00 Lacs with Rs.5134 Lacs as share of Haryana. Haryana Government would seek loan assistance from NCRPB to meet with the expenditure of this project.
- MOU was signed at Delhi on 13.06.2014 between Principal Secretary, PWD (B&R) Haryana and Principal Secretary Public Works Department Govt. of Uttar Pradesh in the presence of Hon'ble Chief Minister Haryana and Chief Minister, Uttar Pradesh.
- According to MOU, the State Governments will construct approach roads and protection
 works in their respective state at their own cost and from their own resources including cost
 of land acquisition whereas the bridge will be constructed by the UP Government.
- The DPR is yet under consideration of SFC-"B" for approval.
- A meeting of project Steering Committee was held on 06.06.2015 at New Delhi under the chairmanship of Engineer-in-Chief (Parikalap and Niyojan) Uttar Pradesh which was attended by Executive Director, HSRDC and Superintending Engineer, Haryana PWD (B&R) Branch Karnal.
- As per minutes of meeting dated 06.06.2015, there is stay on the status of land and the agreed alignment, from Hon'ble Supreme Court. As such, the length of the bridge is likely to increase at the alternative alignment resulting into increase in cost.
- Lately a meeting between the officers of UP PWD and Haryana PWD (B&R) was held on 10.09.2015. On that day, an alignment was identified and it was decided that the feasibility study of this alignment be carried out.
- The feasibility of bridge, approaches, river protection work etc. on UP side (irrespective of the land either it belongs to Haryana State or U.P State) is to be conducted by the Executive Engineer, Construction Division, PWD Baghpat and the approaches along with river protection work on Haryana side (irrespective of the land either it belongs to Haryana State or UP State) by the Executive Engineer, Provincial Division, PWD B&R Br., Panipat.
- The feasibility report is to be submitted with in the period of one month by both the States.
 The MOU is also required to be reviewed.
- The file dealing with the revisiting of MOU and other related issues for the project has been separately submitted for consideration of the Government.

Beside above, Sh. Rishi Kumar Sarin, Sub Divisional Engineer working as Manager and Sh. Navneet Singh, Junior Engineer working as Assistant Manager and Sh. Virender Kumar, SAC on deputation with this Corporation have been repatriated to parent department PWD B&R during the month of August and September 2015, so the total 20 number employees have been removed because of lesser contribution towards HSRDC. Total saving is done for Rs. 4.65 Lac per month.

DEPOSIT OF BALANCE PAYMENTS NOT DEMANDED BY CLIENT DEPARTMENT FOR THE LAST 5 YEARS IN THE GOVERNMENT TREASURY.

An unclaimed amount of Rs.4,58,84,607/- of various departments is lying in the accounts of HSRDC since last five years. This amount has not been claimed by any department / Corporation for the last five years.

These funds can be deposited with Government Treasury after the concurrence of Finance Department.

Board may kindly consider and approve the proposal so that this amount could be deposited in Government Treasury or adjusted against accounts of Thermal Plant Yamuna Nagar which can be adjusted by means of transfer entry by Finance Department.

RELEASING OF FUNDS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF VARIOUS HOUSES IN DEEN BANDHU CHHOTU RAM THERMAL POWER PLANT COLONY AT YAMUNANAGAR.

It is, brought out that the work of construction of residential houses of Group-A (440 sft. block No.4 & 6 sft. block no.2, 1220 sft. block No.2 & 3,2600 sft. block No.1 to 6 & 2775 sft. block No.1) and construction of various houses of group B (440 sft. block no.5,700 Sft. & 1882 sft. block No.7-2 Houses (balance work)at Deen Bandhu Chhotu Ram Thermal Power Plant Colony Yamunanagar is administratively approved for Rs. 64.72 Crore against which funds amounting to Rs. 64.00 Crore have been deposited with this Corporation and an expenditure amounting to Rs. 65.96 Crore has been incurred upto 31.08.2014. The funds deposited with this Corporation have been fully utilized and at present no funds are available.

Further, the funds approximately amounting to Rs. 220.00 Lacs and 5% service charges are still required to clear the pending liability. Two meetings were held on 25.03.2015 and 22.07.2015 under the chairmanship of Additional Chief Secretary to Govt. Haryana Public Works (B&R) Department with HPGCL but all in vain in the meeting held on 22.07.2015 the following decision were taken: -

- (i) No further works are to be executed by State PWD and all the arrangements should be finalized after making joint measurements.
- (ii) HPGCL will take over all the balance buildings on "as and where" basis.
- (iii) Officers / officials of HPGCL can inspect and reconcile the detail of accounts submitted by State PWD on any working day at Chandigarh and Yamunanagar but the requisite funds should be deposited by HPGCL without any further delay in Govt. interest.

Now, M/s Phool Chand & Sons has filed a civil writ petition no.16711 of 2015 in the Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court and the Hon'ble court has disposed of the writ petition with the directions that the notice 80CPC may be disposed of within 2 months.

Further the SE, Chandigarh has informed that the department has no defence but to make the payment of due amount to the agency. The detail of payment due to agency is as under:-

- a) Group-A = Rs.9378810(for the work of Balance work for construction of residential houses of Group-A (440 sft. block No.4 & 6 sft. block no.2,1220 sft. block No.2 & 3,2600 sft. block No.1 to 6 & 2775 sft. block No.1) at Deen Bandhu Chhotu Ram Thermal Power Plant Colony Yamunanagar District.
- b) Group-B = Rs.3323685 (for the work of construction of various houses of group B (440 sft. block no.5,700 sft. & 1882 sft. block No.7-2 Houses (balance work)at Deen Bandhu Chhotu Ram Thermal Power Plant Colony Yamunanagar District.

Under the circumstances explained above, there are the **following alternatives** with this Corporation: -

- (a) To make the due payment to the agency from the existing funds of HSRDC to avoid further litigation and interest.
- (b) To make the due payment to the agency from unclaimed amount of Rs.4,58,84,607/- of various department lying in accounts of HSRDC

Board may kindly consider and approve the action to be taken by HSRDC.

ANNOUNCEMENT OF AWARDS FOR LAND ACQUISITION, OUT OF JURISDICTION LIMIT BY LAND ACQUISITION OFFICER / REVENUE OFFICER.

It has been brought to the notice of this office that Land Acquisition Officers / Revenue Officers announce the awards of land acquisition out of their jurisdiction due to which the Corporation has to face litigation / problem to acquire the land and execution of works are delayed. Even some cases they have not made the payment from the funds deposited for payment and for mutation of various projects, roads improved by the Corporation(Annexure 4)

ENGAGEMENT OF CONSULTANT ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER ON CONTRACT BASIS IN HSRDC

It was desired by Hon'ble PWM vide note dated 05.12.2014 (Annexure 5) that Sh.Singh Ram, Secretary (Retd.) from Haryana Govt. may be engaged on contract basis in this Corporation. Accordingly, Sh.Singh Ram, Secretary (Retd.) was engaged as Consultant Administrative Officer vide this office letter no. 9530/HSRDC dated 22.12.2014 on contract basis for a period six months w.e.f. 05.12.2014 with emoluments as per Govt. instructions of retired Govt. employees.

Further, it was desired by Hon'ble PWM vide note dated 01.06.2015 (Annexure 6) that the re-employment of Sh. Singh Ram may be extended for another one year. Accordingly, the term of contract of Sh. Singh Ram, Secretary (Retd.) was extended for a period of four months w.e.f. 05.06.2015 to 04.10.2015 on the same terms & conditions.

ISSUES PERTAINING TO SOCIAL SAFE GUARD POLICY AS PER ASIAN DEVELOPMENT BANK GUIDELINES.

It is submitted that Board of Directors in its 60th meeting held on 30.06.2015 approved the proposal for reimbursement of payment of Rs.20,53,538/- for payment to 69 persons who have raised temporary structure by encroaching upon PWD land of Gohana - Lakhanmajra - Meham - Bhiwani road. Hon'ble Chief Minister, Haryana on 31.07.2015 has also approved the above proposal of HSRDC.

The case has been referred to Finance Department for its concurrence on 13.08.2015 (Annexure-7). Inspite of various visits to the Finance Department to pursue the matter, the concurrence of Finance Department is yet awaited.

The representatives of ADB and NCRPB are stressing for compliance of Safeguards Policy Settlement, 2009 (SPS) policy of ADB and payment to the 69 persons involved. Member Secretary, NCRPB and Secretary Urban Development, Govt. of India have also talked to ACSPW and Chief Secretary respectively for early compliance of above policy of ADB.

This issue was also raised by NCRPB officers in the High Powered Committee chaired by Chief Secretary held on 20.08.2015.

Lately, a DO letter dated 01.09.2015 has also been received from Sh.M.Venkaiah Naidu, Hon'ble Minster of Urban Development, Housing & Urban Poverty Alleviation and Parliamentary Affairs, Government of India to the address of Hon'ble Chief Minister, Haryana regarding resolving of issues pertaining to social safeguards viz payment of compensation to the title holders, Rehabilitation & Resettlement Assistance for affected structures in respect of projects funded by NCRPB under ADB line of credit being implemented the State Government. Hon'ble CM has desired that necessary action in this regard may be taken in a time bound manner.

Regarding Non payment of compensation to title holders due to adverse possession by PWD (β &R) / Govt. of Haryana, the information is being collected from DRO, Sonepat by Superintending Engineer Sonepat / DGM-III Sonepat

The above position is brought to the notice of Board of Directors for consideration.

The set-up in Public Works (B&R) Department is Chief Engineer and Superintending Engineer between the Engineer-in-Chief and Executive Engineer. Due to frequent transfer of Executive Director, Deputy General Managers and Managers from this Corporation, the quality, misappropriation etc. can take place in absence of multiple scrutiny.

PWD (B&R) is making promotion and placing the services of un-experienced officers with this Corporation without the consent of Managing Director, HRSDC and this Corporation has become parking lot.

Board is requested to consider and approve the following proposal: -

- An independent Chief Engineer may be posted as Executive Director, HSRDC at Head Quarter, Panchkula.
- ii) 1 post of Deputy General Manager, HSRDC at Head Quarter, Panchkula may be upgraded as General Manager equal to Superintending Engineer and he may be posted as independent General Manager, HSRDC at Head Quarter, Panchkula for smooth working of this Corporation.

TO CONSIDER & APRPOVE THE RE-APPOINTMENT OF TAX AUDITORS.

It is brought to the notice of Board that M/s. Rajv Mittal & Co., Chartered Accountant were appointed as Tax Auditors for the Financial Years 2013-14 at a fee of Rs. 10,000/- p.a. plus service tax as applicable. The Corporation has received a request from them for their reappointment as TAX Auditors for the Financial Year 2014-15 on the existing terms and conditions.

The Board is requested to consider and approve the re-appointment of M/s Rajiv Mittal & Co. Chartered Accountants as TAX Auditors for the Financial Year 2014-15.

COURT CASES - ROUTING OF ACRS OF OFFICERS DEALING WITH HSRDC CASES THROUGH MANAGING DIRECTOR, HSRDC.

At present 30 nos. Toll court cases are going on in various courts. In view of decision of Board of Directors, all toll court cases have been transferred to concerned field SEs / EEs with the instructions to depute an official of Circle / Division office to attend the said courts and intimate the outcome of the court case and also to record the proceedings of the court in the Register being maintained by HSRDC and kept in the Reception of the HSRDC office, Sector-2, Panchkula. If it is outside Chandigarh and Panchkula then the court case is to be attended and proceedings are to be intimated to HSRDC by Circle / Division staff on each and every date in writing and subsequently by e-mail.

Besides, 30 nos. Toll court cases, 9 nos. Arbitration cases are also going on in which field SEs / EEs are appointed Presenting Officer(s) / APOs. It has been observed field SEs / EEs do not cooperate at all in view of position explained above. It is therefore, proposed that Arbitration case should also be handled / monitored by Haryana PWD (B&R) Branch.

In view of above, a proposal was sent to Govt. vide this office UO letter no. 122/HSRDC dated 03.08.2015 proposing that, ACRs of officers i.e. SDEs / EEs / SEs should also be routed through Executive Director, HSRDC and Managing Director, HSRDC for the betterment of the works and to watch the Govt. interest in Arbitration cases, but the Govt. has not accepted the proposal of this Corporation.

By virtue of this decision, HSRDC hierarchy shall have no control over the field SEs / EEs and the probability of losing the court cases shall remain.

This is for information of the Board and taking note of the same.

CONSTRUCTION OF LIBRARY AND CONVENTION CENTRE IN DCRUST MURTHAL AT SONEPAT.

The Deputy General Manager-III, HSRDC, Sonepat vide letter no. Spl.1/Camp Pkl. dated 15.9.2015 (Annexure 10) has stated that a great difficulty was faced with regard to the functioning of AC system provided in the library building of DCRUST, Murthal. Now AC system is to be provided in the under construction Convention Centre also. After much deliberations on the system of air conditioning to be adopted in the said building, the consultant has failed to even get the technology of the AC finalized. Thus, the consultant is not having the requisite expertise in the field of AC technology. Even Executive Engineer, Electrical Division, PWD (B&R) Branch, Karnal is also not well conversant with the AC technology prevailing these days and therefore he is not in a position to give expected results / delivery in AC technology of the said building.

The Deputy General Manager-III, HSRDC, Sonepat has requested that a 3rd party Consultant on the pattern of PMGSY may be allowed to facilitate visits for supervision of AC work to be executed in the Convention Center and to have expert advice in the matter and further to avoid any embarrassing situation during the functioning of AC work in future. The department has already faced great criticism on this account in case of Library Building of the University.

The Executive Engineer, Electrical Division, PWD (B&R) Branch, Karnal vide his letter no. 1055 dated 07.09.2015 (Annexure 11) has also recommended for appointment of 3rd party independent consultant for supervision of electrical works in library and convention centre in DCRUST, Murthal. The work of providing fire alarm system, CCTV system, Audio Video system and Substation & DG set in Library and Convention centre in DCRUST Murthal at Sonepat stands allotted to the contractual agencies.

In this connection, it is, submitted that Sh. V.K. Sawal, Chief Engineer (Retired) has been appointed by PWD (B&R) Department as State Quality Monitors in respect of roads already up graded or being upgraded in this state under PMGSY Bharat Nirman by HARRIDA vide letter no. 1475 dated 08.05.2014 (Annexure 12) and he has been allowed following claims: -

- 1. An amount of Rs. 2000/- for every day work (\Re s. 1000/- as daily allowance and Rs. 1000/- as honorarium)
- 2. Incidental charges @ Rs. 500/- per inspection visit.
- 3. Hiring charges of taxi from place of residence to Head Quarter of concerned EE/SE. In case, own car is used for traveling from place of residence to Head Quarter of concerned EE/SE, then TA shall be payable as per norms fixed by the Govt. of Haryana.

In view of above, M/s AKHAI HVAC Consultant Engineers, Panchkula has been appointed as 3rd party consultant for the work of providing AC system / technology, fire alarm system, CCTV system, Audio Video system and Substation & DG set in Library and Convention centre in DCRUST Murthal at Sonepat on the pattern of PMGSY vide this office letter no. 5306/HSRDC dated 16.09.2015 (Annexure 13) and he will be entitled to the following claims only;-

- 1. An amount of Rs. 2000/- for every day work (Rs. 1000/- as daily allowance and Rs. 1000/- as honorarium)
- 2. Regarding providing vehicle for transportation, the consultant will be provided by HSRDC from the place of residence to site and back.

Therefore the total amount payable for every work day would be Rs. 2000/-.

The consultant shall also check as under: -

- a) Designing and Estimation. Whether the estimate prepared is in conformity to the site conditions?
- b) Whether methodology of execution and control measures at site are in order?
- c) Quality of the work, suggest improvement in quality of material and execution methodology to the field staff, wherever necessary & suggest remedial measures, which are required to ensure improvement in quality and timely completion of work.

Further, the visit of consultant for supervision of AC works in convention centre would be only with prior approval of Managing Director, HSRDC.

This is for information of the Board of Directors.

DELEGATION OF FINANCIAL POWERS IN HSRDC.

It is intimated that the above matter was putup before the BOD in 60th meeting held on 30.06.2015 the Board toke the following decision:-

"Board decided to constitute a committee of 3 officers consisting of Executive Director, HSRDC, Chief Engineer (NCR) and CAO to recommend the delegation of powers in HSRDC within 15 days, after studying the extent of delegation granted in other state Corporation of comparable size."

The Committee submitted his report on 11.08.2015 (Annexure 14) which is reproduced as under:-

"After detailed discussion regarding delegation of powers as per provisions of PFR volume-I, This may be further re-delegated as per requirement of the corporation CE (NCR) & CAO were of the view, that delegation may be made as per provisions of power delegations in the PFR which are applicable in all Engineering Departments and ED, HSRDC was of the view that the delegation of powers should be made two and half time of PFR as the powers delegated in PFR were fixed/amended in 2006."

It is for the Board to decide to whether to go for the recommendations made by Chief Engineer (NCR) and C.A.O. or made by ED, HSRDC.

DEMAND OF FUNDS REGARDING LOSS DUE TO PRE-MATURE LIQUIDATION OF FDS AND BANK INTEREST TILL THE AMOUNT OF RS. 100.00 CRORE RECEIVED FROM B&R.

In this connection it is intimated that as per decision taken in the meeting held under in the Chairmanship of Sh. S.S. Dhillon, PSCM on 08.08.2014 and 57th Meeting of BOD HSRDC held on 29th & 30th September 2014, an amount of Rs. 100.00 Crore was deposited with Executive Engineer Provisional Division, PWD B&R Br., Panchkula after taking the approval of PSPW(B&R). To implementation the decision taken in the above meeting, FDRs of HSRDC were premature liquidated. As per following table, an amount of Rs. 46.51 Lacs (Approx.) has to be bear to this Corporation.

In view of the above, an amount of Rs. 46,51,272/- (due to premature liquidation of FDRs) and Rs.1,50,73,960/- (from 17.10.2014 to dated of received

of amount from PWD (B&R)) = Rs. 1,97,25,232/- (Approx.) is required to be received from the PWD (B&R).

There is following two options to avoid audit objection, Income Tax objections and financial implication.

- 1. It will be appropriate to get the approval of Govt. to ask PWD (B&R) department for deposit the above amount with HSRDC at the earliest as possible.
- 2. If above is not possible at this stage, the matter may be placed in the next meeting of the BOD for approval of waving off above amount.

As desired by the Govt., the case was submitted in the meeting of the BOD to wave of the above amount. Accordingly the matter was placed before the Board of Directors in the 59th meeting held on 30.03.2015. The Board has taken the following decision:-

"It was apprised, the case for settlement of the issue of interest and loss arisen on account of premature liquidation of FDRs was sent to the Govt. and as per decision taken, the matter was placed before the BOD. The board desired that the matter may be taken with Finance Department."

The E-in-C, PWD B&R was requested vide this office letter no. 2671/AC dated 23.06.2015 (Annexure 15) for depositing the amount with HSRDC. While reviewing the action taken report of 59th meeting of BOD, the Board taken the following decision:-

"Demand of funds regarding loss due to pre-mature liquidation of FDs and bank interest till the amount of Rs. 100.00 Cr. received from B&R. - EIC PWD (B&R) has been requested to recoup the interest / amount of premature liquidation vide this office letter no. 2671 / AC dated 23.06.2015. Board resolved that PWD B&R should recoup the HSRDC regarding the loss / interest or get an appropriate decision from Finance Department in this regard."

Engineer-in-Chief, PWD (B&R) Haryana in reference to this office memo no. 2671/AC dated 23.06.2015 (Annexure 15) and again was requested vide U.O. no. 19/Ac/2015 dated 12.08.2015 (Annexure 16) but the amount has not been received from PWD B&R. Worthy Additional Chief Secretary to Govt. of Haryana PWD (B&R) and Architecture Department-cum-Chairman, HSRDC has been requested to call a meeting of Engineer-in-Chief, Haryana PWD B&R & Finance Department to resolve the matter.

The matter is placed before the board for perusal please.

Appointment of Independent Director & Woman Director in Haryana State Roads & Bridges Development Corporation Limited.

It is intimated that appointment of two Independent Director and a woman Director is required u/s 146 of the Company Act., 2013. 

The project cited as subject has been approved with NCRPB loan under ADB line of funding. The work stands physically completed.

Superintending Engineer, Rohtak Circle, PWD B&R Rohtak vide his letter No. 928/R dated 24.06.2015 (Annexure-A) has intimated that it was observed during the process of widening of this road in village Bainsl and Lakhan Majra that residents have roised temporary structures such as boundary walls, gates, bathrooms and rattle sheds etc. by encroaching upon PWD land. Total encroachments involved are 69.

Superintending Engineer Britisk has further intimated that in the light of above circumstances, advice of Deputy District Attorney, Circle office dated 15.06.2015 was obtained (Annexure-B). The DDA has opined that compensation to the encroachers can not be paid. According to DDA, instead of making payment, penalty and cost involved for removal of encroachments need to be recovered from each encroacher, in view of sub-section 2 of section -7 of Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulations) Act, 1961.

On the other hand, representatives of ADB & NCRPB are stressing for compliance of Safeguards Policy Settlement, 2009 (SPS) policy of ADB and payment to the 69 persons involved. According to SPS 2009 of ADB, absence of formal and legal title to the land should not prevent the affected person to receive compensation and resettlement assistance from the project (Annexure-C). According to SE Rohtak, financial implication of Rs. 20,53,538/- is involved.

BOD in its 60th meeting hold on 30th June 2015 has approved the payment of Rs. 20,53,538/- on account of above explained compensation to identified affected persons (Annexure -D).

In this regard, it is submitted that a great difficulty was faced with regard to the functioning of AC system provided in the library building of DCRUST, Murthal. Now AC system is to be provided in the under construction Convention Centre also. After much deliberations on the system of air conditioning to be adopted in the said building, the consultant has failed to even get the technology of the AC finalized. Thus, we are well aware that the consultant is not having the requisite expertise in the field of AC technology. Even EE, Electrical of PWD (B&R), Karnal is also not well conversant with the AC technology prevailing these days and therefore is not in a position to give expected results / delivery in AC technology of the said building.

In the light of above, it is humbly requested that a 3rd party Consultant on the pattern of PMGSY may be allowed to facilitate visits for supervision of AC work to be executed in the Convention Center to enable us to have expert advice in the matter and further to avoid any embarrassing situation during the functioning of AC work in future. The department has already faced great criticism on this account in case of Library Building of the University.

M/s AKHAI HVAC Consultant Engineers are well conversant with the AC works and have successfully designed the similar work of Auditorium Building of Medical University, Rohtak. The said AC work is operational in the said building and is working satisfactorily.

Hence, it is recommended that M/s AKHAI HVAC Consultant Engineers, Panchkula may please be considered for appointment as 3rd party consultant on the pattern of PMGSY to safe face from criticism and complete the construction work of Convention Center at the earliest.
