The HPGCL has agreed to release an interim demand of Rs.1.21 Cr. The minutes of meeting is forwarded to SE, Hisar and SE, Karnal with the request to reconcile their accounts and resubmit the case. The funds amounting to Rs.1.21 Cr. is still awaited from HPGCL.

Opening of Personal Ledger Accounts (PLAs) and closing of Bank Accounts.

Finance Department vide his memo TA/HR/DMC/2016/7099 dated 28.10.2016 has advised as under:-

The funds received from NCRPB (75%) as loan are being deposited with the Government of Haryana as PIT and then Haryana Government issue budget grant including the State Share (25%) to the PWD (B&R) Haryana through treasury.

It was decided that in future the funds to the extent of passed bills will be released by the PWD B&R to HSRDC Panchkula. The same will further be disbursed through their bank account within two (2) working days to the concerned agency.

PWD Deptt. will provide this information on quarterly basis to Finance Deptt. and if the parking of funds will remain for more than two working days then this arrangement will be dispensed with. Further the above arrangement is applicable in case of two schemes mentioned at serial No. 2 &3 above."

Regarding the issue of transfer of funds against which the works are being executed by HSRDC, FD has advised that officers of HSRDC and Finance Department Haryana may have detail discussion to find out some ways to avoid parking of funds in Bank Account. Accordingly, FD has been requested by HSRDC to fix up the meeting for the same.

Board was apprised that in between the meeting has been called by FD for the purpose on 27.12.2016. Board desired to apprise it with the outcome of the meeting of the FD fixed for 27.12.2016.

The meeting called by the FD was attended and it was decided that the matter relating to opening of PLA of the HSRDC shall be taken up later on in the next meeting. No meeting thereafter has been called by the Finance Department.

In the meantime, we have received a project for construction of buildings and other ancillaries from BPSMV, Khanpur Kalan Distt. Sonepat about cost of Rs.41.21 Crore – as deposit work, who insisted that a PLA Account be opened to facilitate the payments.

Accordingly the office of Director, Treasury & Accounts, Haryana was visited by AO, HSRDC and discussed the issue regarding opening of PLA Account. During the course of discussion, it was given to understand that a PLA Account of the Corporation can be opened in terms of Clause 1 of the Instruction dated 19.10.2016 issued by Finance Department under memo no. 12/27/2011-3FG-2 dated 19.10.2016. It was further made clear that only the projects having more than 25 Crores of cost, can be considered for opening of PLA Account for the deposit work mentioned above.

Since the project is more than Rs. 25 Crore, as such the matter has been taken up through UO no. 885 dated 09.03.2017 with Finance Department, Haryana for opening of PLA Account.

Board was apprised that efforts are being made to open PLA account for the work relating to BPS Mahila Vishawvidhyalaya, Khanpur Kalan and UO note has been sent to the Co-ordinator, FMCW in Finance Department.

In view of this, SE Hisar has been directed vide this office letter No.837/HSRDC dated 01.03.2017 and reminder No.931/HSRDC dated 06.03.2017 to settle all the bills of the work done and supply the copy of vouchers to HPGCL as desired by MD,HPGCL. SE Hisar / EE Hisarhas telephonically informed that the pending bills are under check and will be passed by 28.03.2017. Thereafter the copy of all the documents relating to the expenditure for re-conciliation will be submitted to HPGCL as already decided.

Board desired that the matter may be perused vigorously for refund pertaining to the year 2006-07 as it has already been delayed much.

On 01.03.2017, the CA and AO HSRDC visited the office of DC Income Tax Panchkula and requested him to refund the amount of Rs.22.10 Lac plus interest pertaining to the AY 2006-07 and a letter was also written to him bearing No. 432/AC dated 01.03.2017. The DC Income Tax has assured that needful will be done in a short span of time.

It was explained to the Board that efforts are being made to get the refund of Income tax of Rs.22.10 lakh plus interest thereon for the year 2006-07 by way of adjustment against the balance demand of Income tax Department for the Assessment Year 2012-13.

Board desired that the matter may be persuaded and results thereof be intimated to the Board in its next meeting.

Company Secretary , HSRDC is constantly in touch with Income the Tax Department. It was desired the Income Tax Department that copies of the Challans vide which the tax has been deposited, be supplied to them as the file relating to the case was not coming up. The requisite documents are beina supplied to the Income Tax Department.

AGENDA ITEM NO. 63.19 FIXED DEPOSITS/FUNDS WITH THE CORPORATION.

After deliberations, it was decided that HSRDC may examine the matter on file and put up with concrete proposal for consideration of Government.

The matter may be perused with Finance Department for early advice in the matter.

A UO reminder has been issued to the Finance Department vide No. HSRDC/799 dated 03.03.2017.

Board desired that a reminder may be issued to Finance Department for expediting the necessary advice in the matter.

Reminder has been issued to Finance Department vide No. 988/ AC dated 07.06.2017 and AO HSRDC personally visited Finance Department and requested the concerned Superintendent for expediting the issue.

Board approved the item to request Finance Department to exempt HSRDC from opening of PLA Account

Finance Department vide his memo TA/HR/DMC/2016/7099 dated 28.10.2016 has advised as under:-

The funds received from NCRPB (75%) as loan are being deposited with the Government of Haryana as PIT and then Haryana Government issue budget grant including the State Share (25%) to the PWD (B&R) Haryana through treasury.

It was decided that in future the funds to the extent of passed bills will be released by the PWD B&R to HSRDC Panchkula. The same will further be disbursed through their bank account within two (2) working days to the concerned agency.

PWD Deptt.willprovide this information on quarterly basis to Finance Deptt. and if the parking of funds will remain for more than two working days then this arrangement will be dispensed with. Further the above arrangement is applicable in case of two schemes mentioned at serial No. 2 &3 above."

Regarding the issue of transfer of funds against which the works are being executed by HSRDC, FD has advised that officers of HSRDC and Finance Department Haryana may have detail discussion to find out some ways to avoid parking of funds in Bank Account. Accordingly, FD has been requested by HSRDC to fix up the meeting for the same.

Board was apprised that in between the meeting has been called by FD for the purpose on 27.12.2016. Board desired to apprise it with the outcome of the meeting of the FD fixed for 27.12.2016.

The meeting called by the FD was attended and it was decided that the matter relating to opening of PLA of the HSRDC shall be taken up later on in the next meeting. No meeting thereafter has been called by the Finance Department.

In the meantime, we have received a project for construction of buildings and other ancillaries from BPSMV, KhanpurKalanDistt. Sonepat about cost of Rs.41.21 Crore – as deposit work, who insisted that a PLA Account be opened to facilitate the payments.

Accordingly the office of Director, Treasury & Accounts, Haryana was visited by AO, HSRDC and discussed the issue regarding opening of PLA Account. During the course of discussion, it was given to understand that a PLA Account of the Corporation can be opened in terms of Clause 1 of the Instruction dated 19.10.2016 issued by Finance Department under memo no. 12/27/2011-3FG-2 dated 19.10.2016. It was further made clear that only the projects having more than 25 Crores of cost, can be considered for opening of PLA Account for the deposit work mentioned above.

Since the project is more than Rs. 25 Crore, as such the matter has been taken up through UO no. 885 dated 09.03.2017 with Finance Department, Haryana for opening of PLA Account.

Board was apprised that efforts are being made to open PLA account for the work relating to BPS MahilaVishawvidhyalaya, KhanpurKalan and UO note has been sent to the Coordinator, FMCW in Finance Department.

Board desired that the matter be persuaded with the concerned quarters for opening of PLA and progress thereof be informed to the Board.

The matter has been referred back by the FD with the direction to the Corporation to take action in accordance with the minutes of meeting dated 18.11.2016.

# OPENING OF PERSONAL LEDGER ACCOUNT (PLA) OF HARYANA STATE ROADS & BRIDGES DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION LIMITED, PANCHKULA.

In order to facilitate the payments against deposit work with a tentative cost of Rs.4100.21 Lakh for construction of BhagatPhool Singh MahilaVishawvidhyalaya, KhanpurKalan (District Sonepat) it was emphasized by the Department and FD that a PLA be opened. The minutes of the said meeting are available at Annexure-VI and a perusal of the minutes( highlighted portion on page 2 of the minutes) reads as under:-

" After detailed discussion and taking the view of PAG officer representative, the offices of PAG was of the view that since these Boards/Corporations are not the DDOs of the State Treasuries/Subtreasuries as these Boards /Corporations are not directly drawing funds from Treasuries so it is not possible to give the authority of opening/operation of the proposed PLA/PD Accounts of the Boards/Corporations. It was advised by PAG office that the Administrative Department of these Boards/Corporation which are Treasuries drawing funds from the and depositing Boards/Corporations Accounts may be authorized to open/operate these PLA/PD accounts. The Head of Department of these Administrative Departments may be declared as DDOs for operation of the PLA/PD accounts. The other guidelines will be the same as in case of the Govt. Departments for opening/operating of PLA/PD account."

The matter is, therefore, placed before the Board to decide as to whether the PLA be opened in accordance with the advice of the PAG and if so, the officer in whose name the account is to be opened.

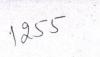

A meeting was held on 18.11.2016 under the Chairmanship of DGTA Cum-Secretary Finance Cum -Advisor to discuss and finalise guidelines for opening/ operation of PLA/PD Accounts for Boards/ Corporations as decided in the meeting dated 14.09.2016

At the outset DGTA apprised the urgency of opening of PLA/PD Accounts for Boards/ Corporations. He further told that huge amount are parked in banks accounts of these Boards/

He emphasized the need of opening of PD/PLA accounts and listed out the advantages of PLA accounts. He referred to the budget documents in this regard. He further mentioned about the manner in which the bank accounts affect the financial position and market borrowing of the State. He also cited the example that at one side the State is borrowing from RBI @ 8.4% (FY 2015-2016), the other's de the State funds are parked in bank accounts on which banks are giving interest @ 4%. he added that the accounts maintenance system of PAG- records expenditure having been incurredthe moment funds are withdrawn from the treasury.

After detailed discussion and taking the views of PAG officer representative, the officers of PAG was of the view that since these Boards/ Corporations are not DDOs of State Treasuries/ Subtreasuries as these Boards/ Corporations are not directly drawing funds from Treasuries so it is not possible to give the authority of opening/ operation of proposed PLA/PD Accounts of Boards/ Corporations. It was advised by PAG office that the administrative department of these Boards/ Corporations which are drawing funds from Treasuries and depositing in these Boards/ Corporations Accounts may be authorised to open /operate these PLA/PD accounts. The Head of Department of these administrative department may be declared as DDOs for operation of these PLA/PD accounts. The other guidelines will be the same as in the case of the Govt Department for opening/operating

Nature of transactions intended to be covered by the Personal Ledger Account The manner in which the funds will be provided for initially in the Personal Ledger Account and in the case of Personal Ledger Account to be opened with Govt money, the major, minor and detailed heads of accounts to which the expenditure will be debited The head of account to which the transactions of the Personal Ledger Account will be

- The arrangements for the local audit of transactions of the Personal Ledger Account

- Finance Department will scrutinize the proposal of each PLA/ PD Account and send the case to Principal Accountant General office.
